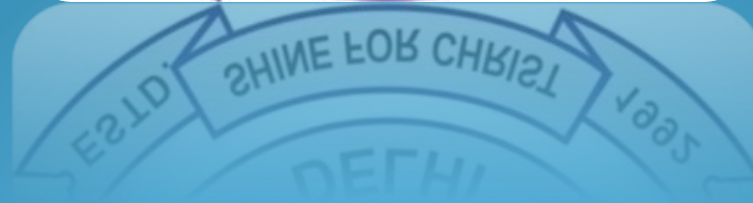


KUKI WORSHIP SERVICE DELHI

Mission Sub-Committee

- ❖ Started in 2009
- ❖ Supports 10 missionaries / workers in Uttar Pradesh (IEM), Nagaland(FMPB), Haryana, Delhi, Mongolia & Tibet Vision
- ❖ Manages missionary fund mobilized mainly through over 200 missionary boxes kept by the members
- ❖ Organizes visits to mission fields

Church Building Project Sub-Committee

- Church Building Project was started in 2002
- In Jan. 2012 the fellowship succeeded in purchasing a plot measuring 1000 sq.yds
- The church building plot is situated at Kanjhawla village, near Rohini in North-West Delhi

KWS Society Governing Body

- ❖ Governing Body's main activity includes fulfilment of statutory requirements of the Society.
- ❖ Oversees social concern projects of the society such as slum ministry in Gokalpuri, North-East Delhi, etc.
- ❖ Gets financial accounts audited, files ITR, manages bank accounts, etc.

Women Fellowship

- ❖ set up in 2002
- ❖ presently, it has about 100 members
- ❖ their main activities are monthly Bible studies, prayer meetings and house visits
- ❖ in 2011, it has successfully sponsored & organised the 1st ever Children Camp
- ❖ extends financial assistance to needy theological students, full time workers, children homes, etc.

Sunday School Union

- Started in 1998, played marvelous role in molding the lives of children
- Today there are about 80 regular students
- Teaching staff comprises of Suptd. and 12 other dedicated teachers, mostly youth.
- Children are divided into 8 groups/classes
- Recently, it has started solfa training classes, children choir & Youth Class
- Outing programs are also organized

Worship Team

- Leads the Sunday worship service in praise & worship
- The Youth Secretaries manages the team
- The team comprises of dedicated & talented young members
- Over the years, the team has grown & contributed to a vibrant & lively worship
- Off late, it has also brought laurels for the fellowship in Gospel music/song competitions
